CS explained that this could be that children were not available and that the ticket costs were low at £2. As before, the school required the children to have certain number of achievement points. 3 of the children did not have enough.

Another parent question was to do with Wisepay. Could they not pay through this app

AE explained that Wisepay would not let the PTA have an account as the PTA needed to be established for at least 3 years. Also, Wisepay have a high charge to use their app.
